Founder's Day Service York Minster 22nd February 2007

As part of the Centenary celebrations a Founder's day service for adults will be held in York Minster starting at 7.30pm. This service is a joint one with North Yorkshire and it is expected that the number of people wishing to go may exceed the number of places available. The District has been allocated 160 tickets. This number has to cover both existing adults and former members of the District. There is no obvious way of allocating the tickets as people may no longer be associated with a Group. It is therefore proposed to use a first come first served basis of allocation but with initially a limit of eight tickets to any Group.
